

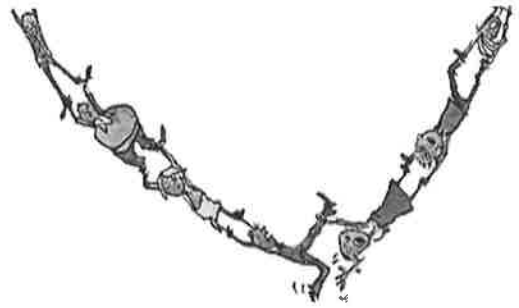
CGBMS CLUBS

8th GRADE ROCKET AMBASSADORS

The 8th Grade Rocket Ambassadors is a service group open to 8th graders who are looking to grow their leadership skills and make a difference in their school. Activities include planning the school-wide PBIS winter assembly, reading daily announcements, and other various projects throughout the school year. The 8th Grade Ambassadors meet 2nd, 3rd, and 4th quarters on Wednesdays during lunch.

CHAIN LINKS CLUB

The CGBMS Chain Links Club is open to all 5th through 8th grade students and meets in the library on Tuesdays from 2:50-3:30 from mid-October through the beginning of April. The goal of the Chain Links Club is to spread a chain reaction of kindness throughout our school, community, and beyond.
