SUMMER SCHOOL 2018

The Cedar Grove-Belgium School District offers a comprehensive Summer School Program for all students who live within our district boundaries, currently attend through open enrollment, and neighboring communities. Courses not requiring additional materials fees are offered free of charge to all district residents, including swimming lessons running summer school hours. Non-residents are encouraged to attend our summer school program which require a non-resident fee, including swimming lessons.

Cedar Grove-Belgium Schools offer both skill building and enrichment courses. Skill building courses, named Reading Adventures and Math Adventures, are remedial in nature and support the skills students need to be successful learners in these areas and continue their academic growth. Enrichment courses provide students with unique and diverse opportunities to extend and explore learning topics of interest to them. All courses have minimum enrollment requirement, so there must be sufficient number of students registered for a class to run. We do our best to run as many courses as possible. Most courses will be held in Cedar Grove-Belgium Elementary School while some may be held in our middle or high school (for older students) after orientation on the first day of summer school. Some classes have a fee to cover costs for supplies. Fees are listed in course descriptions and **paid when submitting registration forms**.

General Information

Assistance with Registrations and Course Fees: Students receiving free and reduced lunch during the school year can receive assistance with course fees. Please note this on your registration form and our school will make arrangements should we need any information or additional documentation.

Attendance: Your child's attendance is important so our teachers can plan engaging, meaningful, effective, and sequential activities for their courses. Please make every effort for your child to attend all classes during our summer school session. If your child is unable to attend classes, please call our school office directly at: (920) 668-8518, extension 300.

Class Cancellations: Should low enrollment courses be cancelled, your child will automatically be assigned one of his/her alternate choices as indicated on your registration form.

Course Selections: On your registration form, you will be asked to list top 5 course choices for each child you are registering, including any Reading or Math Adventure courses your child has been recommended to take. Every effort is made to enroll your child in their top 3 choices. **Fees (if there are any) should be paid at the time of registration for these top three choices.** Return your registration materials to one of our school offices.

Eligibility: All district residents are eligible for summer school. If your child has school choiced into Cedar Grove-Belgium Schools, you should register as if they are district residents. Non-residents are eligible for our summer school program with applicable fees.

Fees: Fees for each child's top 3 course choices **must be paid at the time of registration.**

Location of Classes: Most, if not all classes, will be held at our elementary school campus. On the first day of summer school, ALL classes will meet in the common area/cafeteria at the elementary so students can find their teacher. Some courses may run in our middle or high school. If so, your child will be shown exactly how to get to and from their classroom.

Parking and Drop Offs: The parking lot west of the elementary school is for staff and buses ONLY. Please park at the middle school and walk over to pick up students from summer school.

Skill Builder "Adventure" Courses: Reading and Math (Teacher Referral Required): Additional skill building courses are offered for grade level reading, writing, and math skills. Your children will be recommended for these courses by their classroom teachers. If your child receives a referral for Reading & Writing or Math Skill Builder Adventures, this serves as a STRONG recommendation by our staff as one way to support and develop your child(ren)'s ongoing learning in reading, writing, and/or math during the school year and prepare them for the next grade level. *You are strongly encouraged to register for these courses to help your child succeed and develop their skills in these academic areas if a referral is made by your child's teacher.* Students who register for Reading & Writing and/or Math Adventures will receive registration preference for their choice of enrichment classes to fill their 3 class schedule.

Student Arrival and Dismissal: Students may not arrive for summer school prior to 7:45 am and should wait in the elementary commons prior to the first class. Students are dismissed from classes at 11:45 am and are to leave the school grounds immediately, take their scheduled bus, or be picked up by an approved adult. Students are not to remain on school grounds unsupervised after summer school is over. The District does not provide after school care or supervision. If you are picking your child up early from summer school, please contact the elementary school office at 920-668-8518, extension 300 to make arrangements.

Swimming Lessons: Swimming lessons for levels 1-6 will be offered at 8:00 am, 9:15 am, and 10:30 am with sufficient student enrollment. Lessons run each day during summer school, Monday through Friday. Please see the course catalog for description of swimming lesson levels. Children are expected to largely prepare themselves for swimming lessons. Certified lifeguards and swim instructors will be on site to teach lessons and assist swimmers.

Summer School Course Registration Form: All course choices for all children you are registering can be completed on one *Student Course Registration* Form (last page of this packet). Total the fees for all children and submit one check, payable to Cedar Grove-Belgium Schools.

Transportation: Transportation is provided to and from school from central locations in Belgium and Lake Church. Should any parent/guardian decide that his or her child will not be staying the entire time, the parent/guardian is responsible for pickup and drop off.

ENRICHMENT "FUN" CLASSES

<p>Grades 1, 2, 3, 4</p>	<p><u>Animals By Land and By Sea (ANIM)</u>- Discover the fascinating world of land and sea animals of all types! Why do animals do what they do? Why do they look so different? Through activities, books, in-class projects, and videos, students will learn about the Animal World and how each contributes to our global environment.</p>

SKILL BUILDER ADVENTURE CLASSES

SWIMMING LESSONS

Requirements: Swimmers enrolling in each level must either possess a certificate from or demonstrate all skills from the preceding level. Any child that is lacking the necessary skills will be moved to a level more suitable for their current skill level. Additional information regarding the logistics of swimming lessons during summer school will be sent once enrollment for each course is confirmed.

Swimming Lesson Fees:	District Resident: \$0	Non-District Resident: \$50 per student per course
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Level 1-Introduction to Water Skills (SWM-1)-

Objective: To help students feel comfortable in the water and to enjoy the water safely

Skills Covered: Entering and exiting the water safely, learning to submerge mouth, nose and eyes and breath control, front and back float and recovering to a stand, changing direction in the water, swimming 5 feet on front and back.

Level 2-Fundamental Aquatic Skills (SWM-2)-

Objective: To give students success with fundamental skills

Skills Covered: Entering water by stepping or jumping in from the side, submerging entire head, blowing bubbles, open eyes underwater, front and back glide, swim 15 feet on front and 10 feet on back, swim on side, life jacket use.

Level 3-Stroke Development (SWM-3)-

Objective: To build on skills in Level 2 through additional guided practice

Skills Covered: Jump into deep water, head first entry from sitting or kneeling, submerging and retrieving an object, bobbing, survival float for 30 seconds, treading water for 30 seconds, front crawl 15 yards, butterfly 15 feet, back crawl 15 yards, elementary rescues, safe diving, check-call-care.

Level 4-Stroke Improvement (SWM-4)-

Objective: To develop confidence in the strokes learned thus far and to improve other aquatic skills by increasing endurance through swimming greater distances

Skills Covered: diving, underwater swimming, feet-first surface dive, 1 minute of survival floating, treading and back floating, 25 yards of front crawl, breaststroke and back crawl, 15 yards of butterfly and elementary backstroke and sidestroke, compact jump from height in a lifejacket, throwing assists and caring for conscious choking victim.

Level 5-Stroke Refinement (SWM-5)-

Objective: Coordination and refinement of strokes

Skills Covered: Shallow dive, tuck and pike surface dives, 2 minutes of survival floating & swimming, back float and treading water, flip turns on front and back, 50 yards front and back crawl, 25 yards butterfly, breaststroke, elementary backstroke and sidestroke, rescue breathing.
