SUMMER SCHOOL 2021 General Information

The Cedar Grove-Belgium School District offers a comprehensive Summer School Program for all students who live within our district boundaries, currently attend through open enrollment, and neighboring communities. ALL courses are offered **FREE OF CHARGE** to all district residents, including swimming lessons running during summer school hours. Non-residents are encouraged to attend our summer school program which requires a non-resident fee, including swimming lessons.

Cedar Grove-Belgium Schools offer both skill building and enrichment courses. Skill building courses are remedial in nature and support the skills students need to be successful learners in these areas and continue their academic growth. Enrichment courses provide students with unique and diverse opportunities to extend and explore learning topics of interest to them. All courses have a minimum enrollment requirement, so there must be a sufficient number of students registered for a class to run. We do our best to run as many courses as possible. Most courses will be held in Cedar Grove-Belgium Elementary School while some may be held in our middle or high school (for older students) after orientation on the first day of summer school.

Registration Information: A complete registration for summer school will include:

- ❖ A completed *Student Course Registration Form* (Found at the end of this packet)
- ❖ A completed *Student Summer Transportation Form* (Found at the end of this packet)
- ❖ ***All course selections are due May 3rd to one of our school offices.***
- ❖ Please be aware that while registrations are accepted and welcomed after the deadline, course selections will be set at that time and choices may be much more limited once it is determined which courses will be offered. Please be aware of very limited office hours at the elementary from July 2-July 20. Email communication would be best during this time period, but responses may be delayed. As always, please reach out and ask questions at any time!

General Information

After School Care: Please see the attached document regarding wrap around and after summer school care provided on site in our school by Stepping Stones Day Care. The registration form is also attached.

Attendance: Your child's attendance is important so our teachers can plan engaging, meaningful, effective, and sequential activities for their courses. Please make every effort for your child to attend all classes during our summer school session. If your child is unable to attend classes, you **MUST** call our school office directly at: (920) 668-8518, extension 300, just like you would during the regular school year.

Beginner Band: (Session 2, grades 5 and 6 only) Beginner Band is the first level of band where students will have the opportunity to choose and learn a woodwind, brass or percussion instrument. No experience is necessary – only the will and desire to play an instrument

Class Cancellations: Should low enrollment courses be cancelled, your child will automatically be assigned one of his/her alternate choices as indicated on your registration form.

Course Selections: On your registration form, you are asked to list top 5 course choices for each child, including any Reading or Math skill builder courses your child has been recommended to take. Every effort is made to enroll your child in their top 3 choices. Return your registration materials to one of our school offices.

Eligibility: All district residents are eligible for summer school. If your child attends Cedar Grove-Belgium Schools as a result of school choice, you will register as district residents. Non-residents are eligible for our summer school program with applicable fees.

Face Coverings: A decision regarding face coverings has not been made at this time. Between now and the end of the school year, the district will continue to monitor the health and safety status of our schools and surrounding communities. A decision will be made in late May and communicated to families well in advance.

Fees: All courses are **FREE** to district residents. Non-district families have fees described in the course catalog.

Location of Classes: Most classes will be held at our elementary school campus. On the first day of summer school, ALL classes will meet in the common area/cafeteria at the elementary so students can find their teacher. Some courses may run in our middle or high school. If so, your child will be shown exactly how to get to and from their classroom.

Parking and Drop Offs: Parking, pick ups, and bussing procedures for summer school are identical to what is done during the regular school year.

Residency: District residents are defined as those families and students who reside within the district boundaries of Cedar Grove-Belgium School District. Children or families who attend our schools via school choice are also considered to be district residents.

Skill Builder Courses: Reading and Math (Teacher Referral Required): Additional skill building courses are offered for grade level reading, writing, and math skills. Your children will be recommended for these courses by their classroom teachers. If your child receives a referral for Reading & Writing or Math Skill Builder, this serves as a STRONG recommendation by our staff as one way to support and develop your child(ren)'s ongoing learning in reading, writing, and/or math during the school year and prepare them for the next grade level. *You are strongly encouraged to register for these courses to help your child succeed and develop their skills in these academic areas if a referral is made by your child's teacher.* Students who register for Reading & Writing and/or Math will receive registration preference for their choice of enrichment classes to fill their 3 class schedule.

Student Arrival and Dismissal: Students may not arrive for summer school before 7:45 am and should wait in the elementary commons before the first class. Students are dismissed from classes at 12:00 pm and are to leave the school grounds immediately, take their scheduled bus, or be picked up by an approved adult. Students are not to remain on school grounds unsupervised after summer school is over. If picking your child up early from summer school, contact the elementary school office at 920-668-8518, extension 300 to make arrangements.

Swimming Lessons: Swimming lessons for levels 1-6 will be offered at 8:00 am, 9:20 am, and 10:40 am with sufficient student enrollment. Lessons run each day during summer school, Monday through Thursday. Please see the course catalog for description of swimming lesson levels. Certified lifeguards and swim instructors will be on site to teach lessons and assist swimmers.

Summer School Course Registration Form: All course choices for all children you are registering can be completed on one *Student Course Registration* Form. Return forms to Elementary office - **Family Information, Student Registration, Student Transportation, Stepping Stones Registration (as needed).**

Transportation: Transportation is provided to and from school from locations in Belgium and Lake Church. Parents/guardians are responsible for early pickups and drop offs. **Changes in bus pick up and drop off locations are NOT PERMITTED after the first day of summer school!**

All courses are **FREE** to district residents. Enrichment courses have a \$25 per course non-district resident fee.

<p>Grades 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 Offered: Session 1 & 2</p>	<p>Art Adventures- Create amazing art this summer using a variety of materials like paint, watercolor, oil pastels, chalk and so much more. Make masterpieces using your imagination and curiosity!</p>
<p>Grades 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 Offered: Session 1 & 2</p>	<p>Basketball- Learn the game of basketball through skill building activities, team and partner challenges, drills, fun games, and more! Improve your skills! Have fun! This course explores all aspects of teamwork, sportsmanship, cooperation, skill building, and safety as students learn and play the game of basketball. Students will be grouped by age.</p>
<p>Grades 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 Offered: Session 1 & 2</p>	<p>Celebration: Summer!- Soak up the summer sunshine by enjoying summer time activities. Students will have the opportunity to play with chalk, make summer related crafts and enjoy the great outdoors. The students will learn new outdoor & water games & activities.</p>
<p>Grades 6, 7, 8 Offered: Session 1 only</p>	<p>Coding Ninja- The introduction to Programming in Karel course is designed for beginners with only some background in computer science. Note: This course will take place in Room 121 at the high school.</p>
<p>Grades 3, 4, 5, 6 Offered: Session 1 only</p>	<p>Fizz, Bubble, & Pop!- Designed for the chemist at heart! Discover the basics of chemistry and the importance of matter in the natural world, the human body, and the foods we eat. Students will learn about the types of chemical reactions, how they occur, the states of matter, and other fascinating parts of our chemical world by doing hands-on chemistry experiments, projects, and observations. Experiments will use common household items and explore chemical reactions found in your daily life!</p>

Our three week program will be broken up into three exciting topics including ocean science experiments, under the sea cooking, and outdoor water fun! This class includes all the best parts summer school has to offer while keeping our youngest students in the same classroom with other students of the same age. SKILL BUILDER CLASSES

(Teacher Referral/Approval Required)

All courses are **FREE** to district residents. All skill builder courses have a \$25 per course fee for non-district residents.

Reading & Writing Skill Builders- Skill Builder courses are offered for students needing additional academic support and skill work. Students are recommended by their classroom teacher. Lessons, skill work, and activities are designed to be high interest, engaging, and appropriate for your child's developmental skill level.

Under the Sea with ABC's & 1,2,3's (June)

Happy Campers (August)

1st Grade Reading/Writing- Reading/writing course for students entering 1st grade next school year.

2nd Grade Reading/Writing- Reading/writing course for students entering 2nd grade next school year.

3rd Grade Reading/Writing- Reading/writing course for students entering 3rd grade next school year.

4th Grade Reading/Writing- Reading/writing course for students entering 4th grade next school year.

5th Grade Reading/Writing- Reading/writing course for students entering 5th grade next school year.

6th Grade Reading/Writing- Reading/writing course for students entering 6th grade next school year.

1st Grade Math- Math course for students entering 1st grade next school year.

2nd Grade Math- Math course for students entering 2nd grade next school year.

3rd Grade Math- Math math course for students entering 3rd grade next school year.

4th Grade Math- Math course for students entering 4th grade next school year.

5th Grade Math- Math course for students entering 5th grade next school year.

6th Grade Math- Math course for students entering 6th grade next school year.

***If you wish to have your child participate in skill builder courses and have not received a referral, please contact your child's current classroom teacher to make arrangements for one.

SWIMMING LESSONS

All courses are **FREE** to district residents. All swim lesson classes have a \$50 per course fee for non-district residents.

Requirements: Swimmers must either possess a certificate from or demonstrate skills from the preceding level. Any child that is lacking the necessary skills will be moved to a level more suitable for their current skill level.

Level 1-Introduction to Water Skills- **Objective:** Help students feel comfortable in the water and to enjoy the water safely
Skills Covered: Entering and exiting the water safely, learning to submerge mouth, nose and eyes and breath control, front and back float and recovering to a stand, changing direction in the water, swimming 5 feet on front and back.

Level 2-Fundamental Aquatic Skills - **Objective:** To give students success with fundamental skills
Skills Covered: Entering water by stepping or jumping in from the side, submerging entire head, blowing bubbles, open eyes underwater, front and back glide, swim 15 feet on front and 10 feet on back, swim on side, life jacket use.

Level 3-Stroke Development - **Objective:** To build on skills in Level 2 through additional guided practice
Skills Covered: Jump into deep water, head first entry from sitting or kneeling, submerging and retrieving an object, bobbing, survival float for 30 seconds, treading water for 30 seconds, front crawl 15 yards, butterfly 15 feet, back crawl 15 yards, elementary rescues, safe diving, check-call-care.

Level 4-Stroke Improvement - **Objective:** To develop confidence in the strokes learned thus far and to improve other aquatic skills by increasing endurance through swimming greater distances
Skills Covered: diving, underwater swimming, feet-first surface dive, 1 minute of survival floating, treading and back floating, 25 yards of front crawl, breaststroke and back crawl, 15 yards of butterfly and elementary backstroke and sidestroke, compact jump from height in a life jacket, throwing assists and caring for conscious choking victim.

Level 5-Stroke Refinement- **Objective:** Coordination and refinement of strokes
Skills Covered: Shallow dive, tuck and pike surface dives, 2 minutes of survival floating & swimming, back float and treading water, flip turns on front and back, 50 yards front and back crawl, 25 yards butterfly, breaststroke, elementary backstroke and sidestroke, rescue breathing.

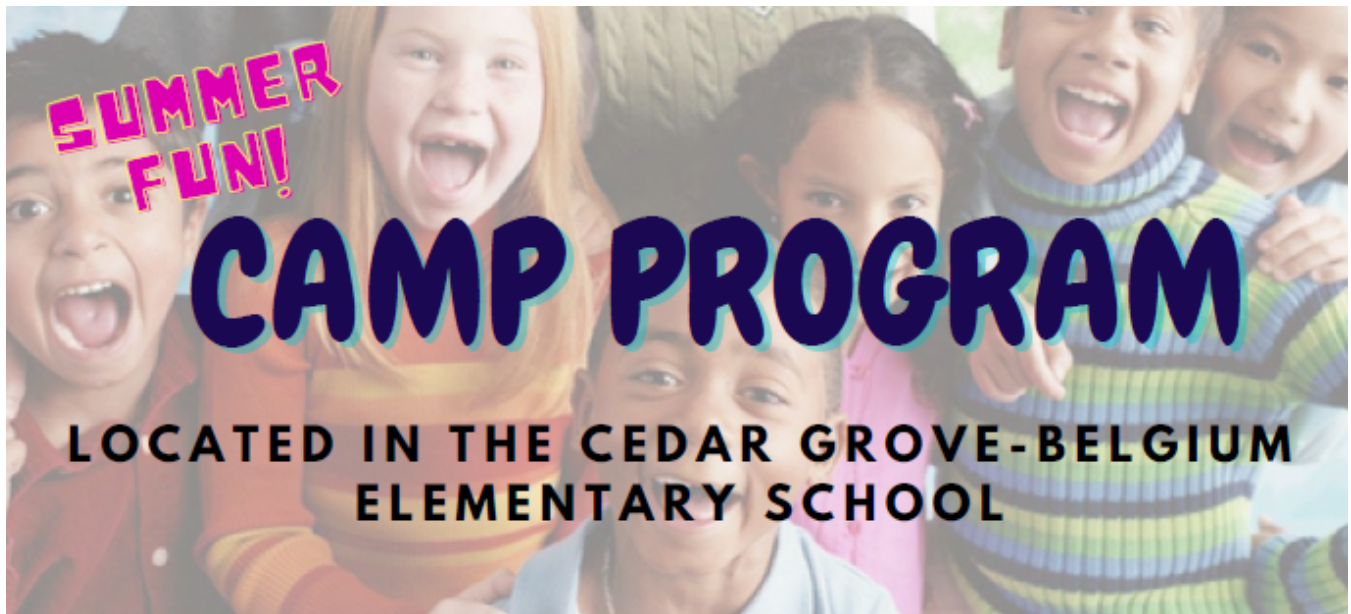
